## MODERN TOOLKIT Workshop in Barcelona

A workshop on MODERN was organised by eucen during the 2016 Autumn Seminar on *Digitalisation in university continuing education: Technology, content and pedagogy*, held on 24-25 November in Barcelona. The aim of the activity was to present the project and offer to participants a first-hand experience of some of the tools selected to be included in the MODERN toolkit.

After being introduced to the project aims and main features, the participants were divided into four groups. Each group was then assigned a specific e-learning tool to discover and assess among these four:



- Ed Puzzle – Course Creation
- Kahoot - Quizzing, polling and assessment tools
- Digital Assess – quizzing, polling and assessment tools
- Blackboard – Course Management

Each group worked with a laptop and was provided with an USB key containing relevant links useful to check out the main characteristics of the respective tool. Participants first discussed and got familiar with the tool within their group, and then shared their impressions with the other groups in an open debate.

14 people in total attended the workshop, actively participating and showing considerable interest in the project's outputs and in the upcoming steps!
